# Oops, They Did It Again!

# UCSD's Speech & Debate Team Punctuates the 2022-23 Season with Another Major Tournament Championship

On Saturday, April 22, 2023, the final major tournament of the intercollegiate speech and debate season was held. The UCSD Speech & Debate Team attended (virtually) the National Online Forensics Quarterly Tournament #4 and *convincingly* and *emphatically* dominated and won the Tournament Championship.

In this single division (Senior/Open) all events tourney, Northern Arizona University achieved 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, compiling 20 tournament championship sweepstakes points. Cal State Northridge edged past NAU with 25 points to seize 2<sup>rd</sup> Place. UCSD captured the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Tournament Championship, amassing 150 points!

Of the 35 team members participating, 19 medaled, earning either Bronze (3<sup>rd</sup> Place), Silver (2<sup>nd</sup> Place), or Gold (1<sup>st</sup> Place) in their events.
