at Pi Kappa Delta!



The UCSD Speech & Debate Team sent its top 14 Team Members to the Pi Kappa Delta National Speech and Debate Tournament, held on the campus of Glendale Community College in Glendale, Arizona, March 7-11. Six additional Team Members submitted speech competition entries via the asynchronous portion of the tournament.

In only its third attempt at competing in a national tournament and competing with over 50 colleges and universities from across the nation, the UCSD Speech and Debate Team captured the National Championship in *two* debate formats. The team of Felip Gerdes and Jared Hoffart (Team Captain) won the NPDA (two vs. two) competition. Kiran Kumar won the IPDA (one vs. one) competition. The team of Julian Mackenzie and Carter Castillo took 2nd Place in the Public Forum debate format competition.

For total school performance, UCSD captured **2**nd **Place in the all-formats debate sweepstakes competition and ranked 3**rd **in overall speech and debate competition combined**. For speech events alone, UCSD earned an "**Excellent**" Award for finishing in the top 20% of schools.
